Stephen was not afraid. God allowed him to look right into Heaven and to see the Lord Jesus.

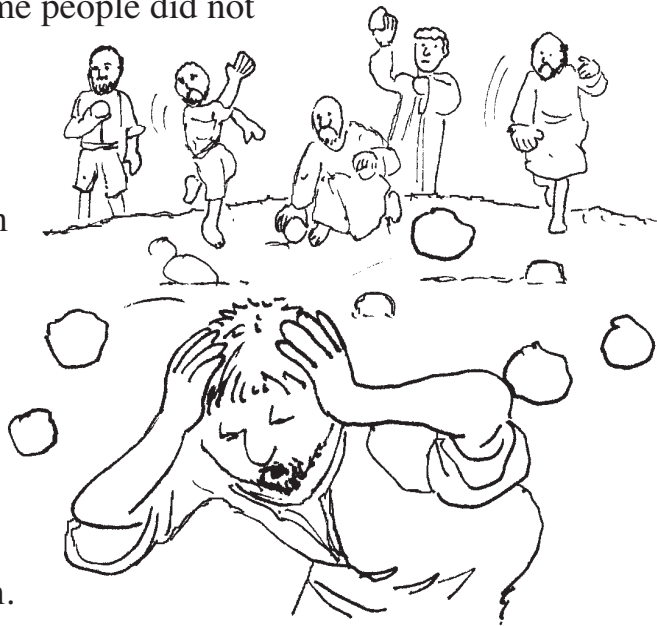

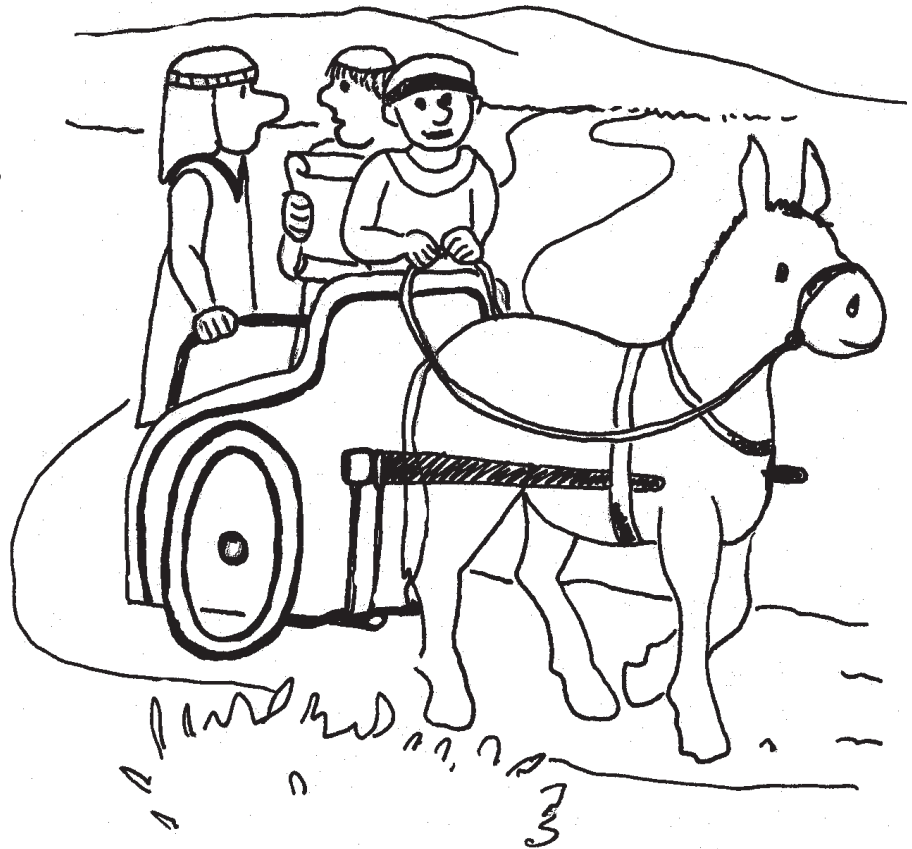

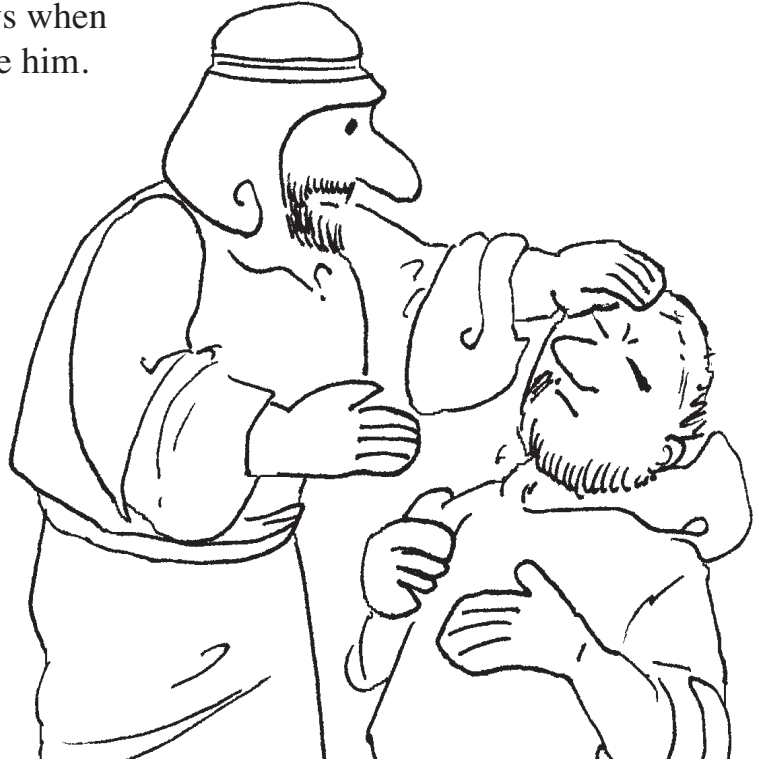
