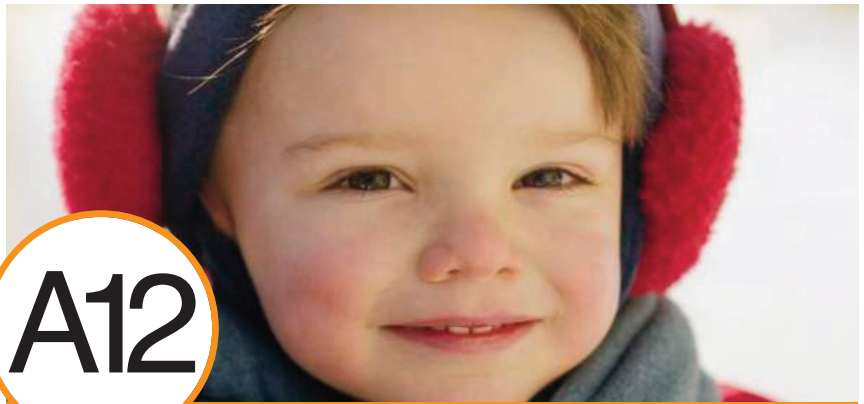

One day Zechariah was working in the Temple. An angel came and told him that soon his wife would have a son. They were to call his name John.

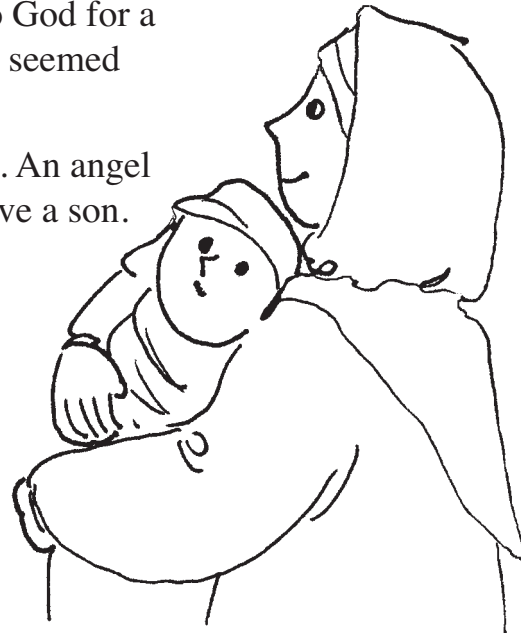
Who was going to have a baby?

God's promises coming true*

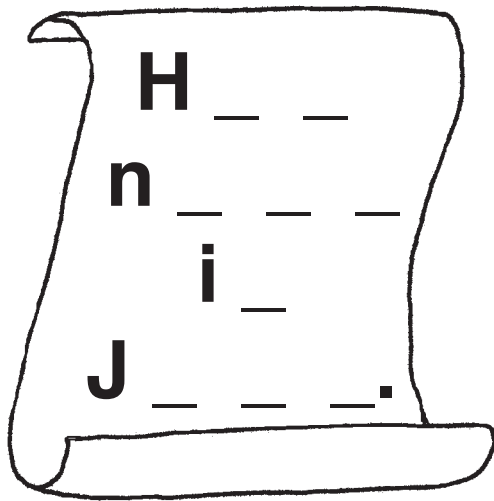

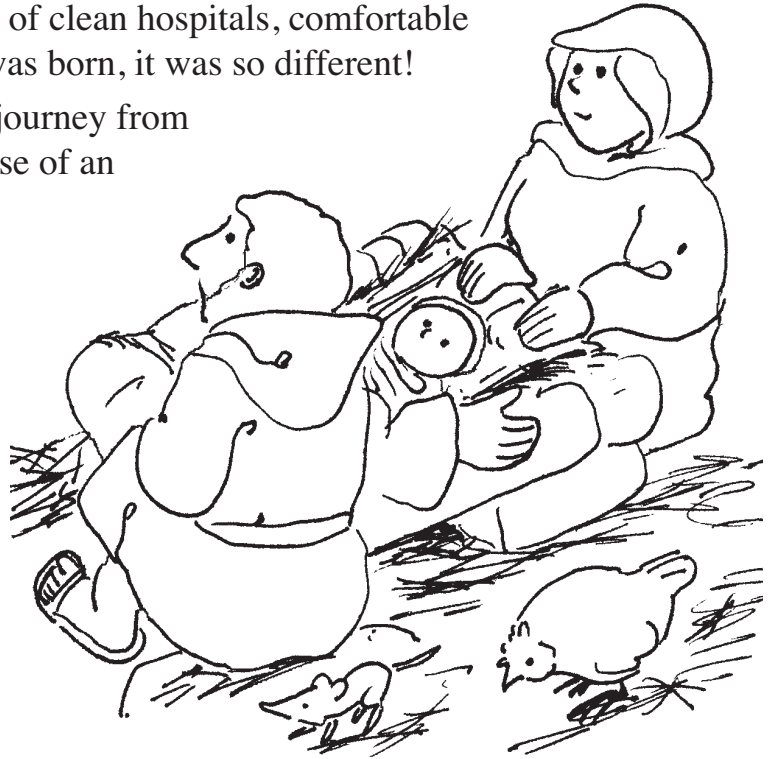
