When he found Him, he begged Him to come. But Jesus told him to go back home, for his son was healed. The man at once believed what the Lord Jesus had said and set out for home.

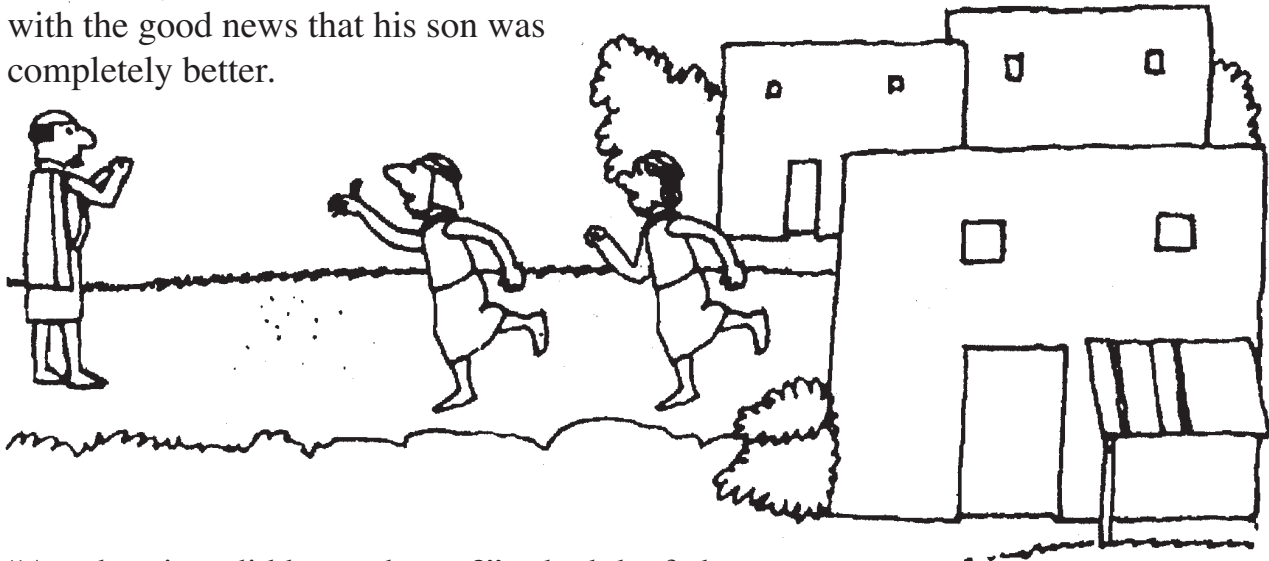

On his way home, his servants met him with the good news that his son was completely better.



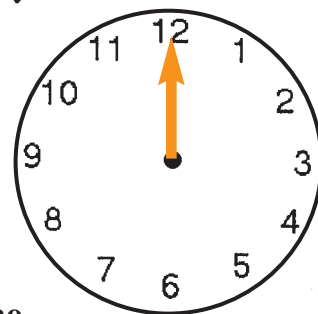
“At what time did he get better?” asked the father.

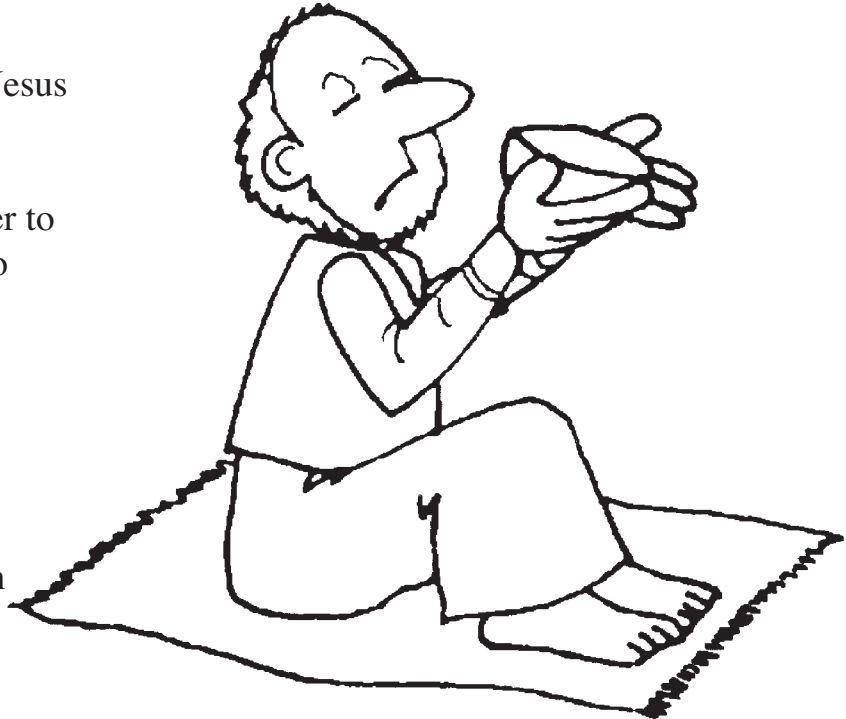
Bartimaeus lived in Jericho. Because he was blind, he sat at the side of the road begging for money.
