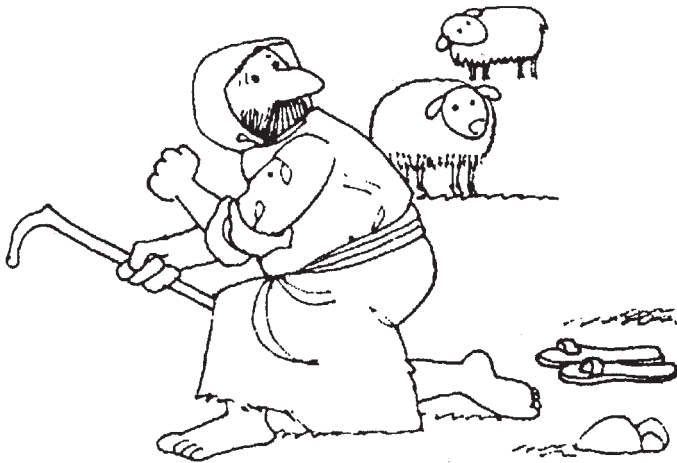


Exodus 3: 1-22

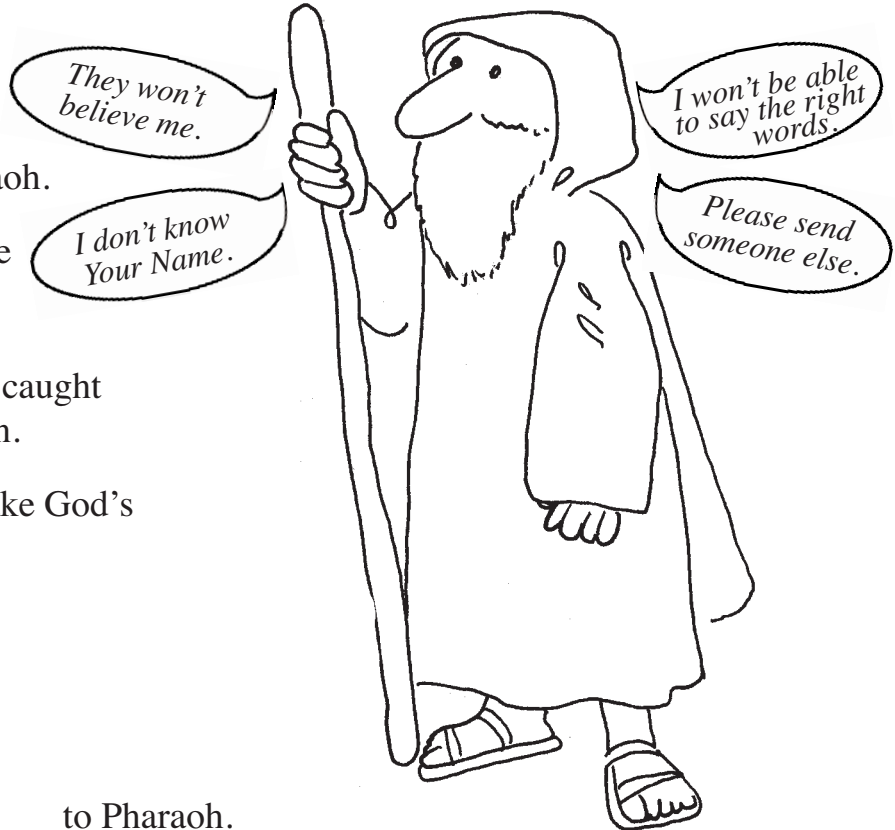
