

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Thinking Herod would know where the Child was, the Wise Men went to him and asked:









How did the Wise Men feel when they saw the star?



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
Soon the Wise Men arrived at Bethlehem and found the house where Jesus, Joseph and Mary were staying. When they saw Jesus they



Have you ever waited a long time for some news? Herod had been waiting for the return of the Wise Men. But they did not arrive! They had obeyed God and gone straight home.

Herod became very angry and decided that every boy in Bethlehem who was under two years old must be killed!

What a terrible thing to do! All because Herod was so worried that this Child might one day be King instead of him.

Again, God spoke to Joseph in a dream. He told Joseph to take his family and escape to Egypt. There he would be safe until God told him to return.
