



Count them and put the number on one of the pots.

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
The Lord Jesus told the servants to fill them with water. It was a lot of work, but the servants did exactly as He had said - they filled them all up to the brim.

Lesson No. 2 - Jesus heals a sick boy



It was a long journey of about 20 miles, but the nobleman didn't complain about the distance. His son was very sick and he wanted to ask Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal him.
