

As Jesus thought about His dear friend Lazarus whom He loved, and all the sadness his death had caused, He cried too.




Then Jesus did a very strange thing. He asked some of the people at the tomb to take away the stone. Next, He called out in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out!”


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Shade in the word going down which describes Lazarus at the end of the story.




Some people do many things to help us. These people are special to us. It is good to say 'Thank you' to them in return for all they do for us. Perhaps you have given a 'Thank you' present.




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Draw what you might give.
