



As they walked along, they talked about what had happened to Jesus. For them, it was very disappointing; they had been so sure He was the Deliverer, or Christ, whom God had promised.




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But now He was dead! (At least, that's what they thought!) They just couldn't understand why it had happened.

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


When they reached Emmaus, they invited Him to come into their house. They prepared food, and just as they began to eat, they recognized Him. He was their Lord and Master, Jesus!
